<u>Itinerary</u>

Saturday 21st Oct: Fly from Manchester to Beijing, China (Departure: 12:15 p.m., Arrival: 05:25 a.m.)

Sunday 22nd Oct: Arrive in Beijing in the morning, pick up from Terminal 2 - Beijing Capital International Airport. After breakfast, explore the historical face of Beijing with a brief visit to Tiananmen Square and The Forbidden City.

After lunch, enjoy a trip on a rickshaw on the **HuTong Alley tour**. **Hutong** is a Mongolian word meaning water-well. Experience the unique nature of the alley's layout and structured lanes and live as the ancient Beijing citizens did, walking around the twisted lanes (home visit included).

Monday 23rd Oct: After Breakfast, attend an all-day school visit at International School of Beijing. After dinner, make our way over to Chaoyang Theatre to enjoy the Acrobat show. Return to the hotel after the performance.

Tuesday 24th Oct: In the morning, pay a visit to JingDong (JD) company. Headquartered in Beijing, JingDong Company is one of the biggest ecommerce companies in China. After lunch, visit the Summer Palace, recognised as 'The Museum of Royal Gardens' and constructed for the royal families to rest and entertain in the luxurious royal gardens. Re-live the palace as the royals did and see what they used to, enjoy then dinner. After dinner, back to hotel.

Wednesday 25th Oct: The sightseeing today starts with Mutianyu Great Wall then to Ding Tomb after lunch.



<u>Itinerary</u>

Thursday 26th Oct: Escort to airport then fly to Chengdu. Arrive in Chengdu in the morning at 10:40 a.m.). Take a break after arrival to the hotel; and get ready for The Giant Panda Breeding Research Base - home to 152 giant and 76 red pandas (figures from 2015). The base focuses on creating the right habitual environment for them to breed.

Friday 27th Oct: After breakfast, a school visit to Confucius International School in Chengdu. In the afternoon, pay a visit to Liu's Manor. It is well-known for its combination of Eastern and Western architectural cultured building.

After dinner, enjoy the 'Face-Changing' performance at China Opera House.

Saturday 28th Oct: In the morning, visit Wuhou Temple and walk around the lively streets at Jinli Old Street full of local snacks, delicate artefacts and folk shows; a city culture exploring day! In the afternoon, arrive at the Leshan Buddha. The Buddha is located to the east of Leshan City, Sichuan Province. See the 71-meter high Giant Buddha, the largest carving in the world. Built between 713 and 803 (during the Tang Dynasty), depicting Maitreya, it took 90 years to finish.

Sunday 29th Oct: After breakfast, escort to airport, for a flight to Beijing. Pick up at Beijing Airport Terminal 1. After lunch, a tour around YongHe Lamasery, followed by a visit to the Temple of Heaven - where Emperors of the Ming (1368 – 1644) and Qing (1644 – 1911) Dynasty held the Heaven Worship Ceremony. As the most representative ancient sacrificial building, it is even bigger than the Forbidden City!

In the evening, escort to Beijing airport for a flight to the UK.
